What you should bring when applying for financial aid:

To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need:

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your most recent federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically (help is available).

If you are a <u>dependent student</u>\*, then you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).

\*If you were not born before January 1, 1994, are not married, or do not have children who receive more than  $\frac{1}{2}$  their support from you, you are probably a <u>dependent student</u> and will need to provide your parent's information.
